Music for the Senses is a showcase of over 80 incredible artworks, murals, mosaics, and installations – each one celebrating the people, places, moments, and instruments of Manchester's legendary music scene.

Musicians including Busted, Doves, Elbow, Mani, New Order, Oasis, PINS, and Pixies have donated precious instruments which you'll find displayed in windows and venues across the city, alongside 48 guitars which have been transformed into one-of-a-kind unique artworks.

On King Street, Manchester artist Lazerian has created Guitar Street - an interactive installation made from 40 donated guitars. Each one features the stencilled face of a young, up and coming music artist from the city, all brought together in a powerful hanging exhibition.

You can also step inside Lazerian's Cathedral of Sound – a show stopping installation built from hundreds of reclaimed acoustic guitars, reimagined into a living, breathing sanctuary of sound. This architectural pavilion acts as a tribute to Manchester's rich musical heritage while embracing its evolving sonic future. It appears in St Peter's Square (7–20 July), then moves to Mayfield Park (25 July–31 August).

There are four brand-new murals from international street artists Lei-Mai LeMaow, Nomad Clan, .EPOD and AKSE P19 to discover, and along the way, don't miss the Manchester Music Mooch – an interactive journey through the locations of Manchester's grassroots music community.

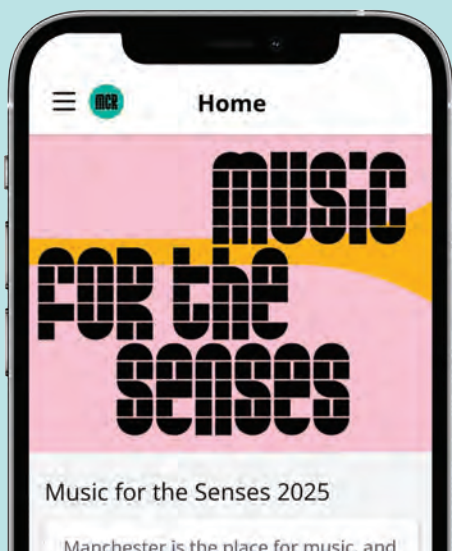

The music industry has changed. As global superstars fill arenas and ticket prices soar, it's becoming harder than ever for new talent to break through.

Grassroots venues – the lifeblood of local scenes and the launchpad for countless artists – are struggling to survive. And for emerging musicians, a lack of funding, resources, and support often stands in the way.

The Forever Manchester Grassroots Music Fund is here to help.

On 12 September, 60 hand-painted guitars – some gifted by well-known artists, including Oasis, Elbow, Doves and many more – will be auctioned to raise money for the fund.

Managed by our charity partner Forever Manchester, the fund will champion the people and places that keep Greater Manchester's music scene alive: independent venues, community events, local festivals, and the artists at the heart of it all.

It's never been easier to explore the city and enjoy the guitar trail by bus and tram using contactless tap and go. Just tap with the same card or device every time and we'll work out the fare for you.

Or if you're travelling as a family then a travelcard might be best for you. If travelling by bus, you can get unlimited bus travel all day for £9 for the whole family, or for tram, it's no more than £7.30 for all day tram travel.* Buy your bus travelcard on the Bee Network app and tram travelcard at the ticket machine at your tram stop.

And when you're out and about on the trail, make sure you swing by Shudehill Interchange to see the Manchester Music Map guitar, and the Etihad tram stop to see our latest artist display. Don't forget to use the Music for the Senses app to unlock your reward when you visit and be in with a chance of winning a special prize!
